· Admission Procedure ·

Parents seeking admission for their ward in St. Xavier's Senior Sec. School, Bahrampur Ram Nagar, have to Submit in the school office the duly filled in application form available along with the prospectus after paying the registration fees.

- 1. The school will register the names of the students for grades Nursery to IX & XI as per the application forms received,
- 2. Written test will be conducted in the following subjects English, Science/EVS and Mathematics. The test will be one hour duration for each of these subjects conducted on a single day.
- 3. The syllabus for test will cover the portion, taught during the previous class and questions of general aptitude. The results will be declared within two working days and the admission will be confirmed subject to submission of following documents:
- Two passport size Photographs ward and Parents.
- Aadhar Card of the child and Parents has to be submitted at the time of admission.
- Previous School Report Card
- Birth Certificate for Class Nursery to 1st as issued from the office of Birth of the Local District Administration.
- Previous School Transfer Certificate for 2nd to 9th and 11th along with Personal Education Number (PEN) And other Board must have Counter signed.

Note: It is mandatory to submit all relevant documents pertaining to the child to avoid complications at a later stage.

Book Shop and Stores

A small bookshop runs independently by a shopkeeper in the school premises for books and stationery items for the students. The materials needed for art and craftwork are also made available at reasonable rates. However, the students are free to purchase from anywhere.

School Transport

The school operates a fleet of buses for the convenience of the parents. The transport facility is made available at reasonable rates. A separate transport form has to be filled in at the time of admission to avail this facility.









Our Different Houses

The students are divided into Four houses called Red Eagle, Yellow Tiger, Blue Dragon and Green Scorpion thus providing opportunities for healthy competition in sports and other activities. Capacity building programs

In order to enhance the teaching skills and professional development of teachers, regular workshops are conducted by experts in the field of education. Special Tutorial Classes

Special tutorial classes will be held for students whose performance is not satisfactory or they find a particular subject difficult. These classes will be held for one hour soon after school hours.

School Improvement Plan (SIP)

A comprehensive School Improvement Plan is developed keeping in view all the parameters of





schooling. The roadmap to improvement is defined and explained to all the teachers and the staff of the school. The principal, teachers and all the staff work towards achieving the goals set in the SIP. The inputs and support of the parent volunteers in this regard is welcome.

Assessment of Teachers

It is very essential to assess the competence of teachers periodically. It is not a fault-finding mission but to help teachers identify their strengths and weakness and help in professional growth. The assessments done are discussed with the individual teachers at a personal level to encourage them perform better.

Parent Teacher Meetings (PTM)

It is important to know the teachers teaching your ward. All parents are earnestly requested to attend every PTM and discuss the issues with the class teacher and all subject teachers of their ward. Apart from that the parents can also meet the principal to address their issues if any.
